

# **Iron Workers Local 112 Selected Apprentice Applicant Requirements**

*Applicants selected and placed into the program must be able to furnish their own transportation, purchase textbooks, tools and stay current on their dues.*

## **Transportation Requirements**

Ironworker apprentices must maintain a valid driver's license, be able to furnish their own transportation and be agreeable to a certain amount of travel. Many times construction sites are located outside the metropolitan area and require reliable transportation.

## **Textbook Requirements**

This is a three year/6000 hour program of on the job training, plus no less than 204 hours of related classroom and shop training per year. Related training classes are held 4 weeks per year. There will be no work allowed for these weeks on class days. You will be required to purchase a laptop or Chromebook computer for online course instruction (\$300 est. value).

## **Tool Requirements**

Ironworkers must provide their own hand tools as necessary for the type of work they are performing. Initial cost for the basic tools an apprentice will need is approximately \$500.

## **Apprentice Initiation Fee**

New apprentices are required to pay a \$100.00 initiation fee upon signing your apprentice agreement.

## **Dues Requirements**

Apprentice members are required to pay \$33.50 per month dues and be a current member in the Voluntary Death Benefit Fund. It is \$12.50 to sign up and \$7.50 per each members deaths thereafter if that member is current in the death benefit fund.
